Virginia to leave ERIC

Yesterday, the Youngkin administration announced its intent to leave ERIC, the Electronic Registration Information Center. ERIC may have been started with the best of intentions, but in recent years had become a way to promote voter fraud. The fact that liberals are so upset over Virginia being the 8th state to leave ERIC, shows that Governor Youngkin and Head of Elections Susan Beals did the right thing
