

Dear Friends and Fellow Republicans

Last night, I was in Bedford County for two different events. 1st was the Bedford Town Council Candidate Forum, and 2nd was the Bedford County GOP Committee Meeting. Being a political nerd, I love candidate forums of all types (even if this was in CD 5 and not CD 6) and wanted to root on Team GOP, but the real story behind this newsletter is what happened at the GOP meeting last night.

Amendment 1 (again say Yes on Amendment 1) to this and that, the Unit Chair, Tim Griffin, gave his Chairman's Report, on how this election is from his perspective.

Chairman Griffin talked about how history has chosen some shocking people to be the facilitators of change in this country.
