

Now It's Over

Last night, New Hampshire gave a large victory to our 45th President, Donald Trump. Try as she might, Nikki Haley was not able to overcome the Trump wave, and, unless a miracle occurs, Donald Trump will be the nominee of the Republican Party in 2024 for President. With over 94% of the vote counted, Trump has an 11.1% lead, and that lead has been in the 10-11% range since they started counting the votes.

As things currently stand, there is no path to victory for Nikki Haley. The next 2 nomination events are the Nevada Caucus (where Haley is not participating, and the US Virgin Islands. Then comes the South Carolina primary. You'd think that in a state where Haley used to be governor, Haley would have a good chance to win. Yet both US Senators from SC (Lindsay Graham and Tim Scott) have endorsed Trump, and earlier this week Congresswoman Nancy Mace endorsed Trump. Currently Trump is ahead in the polls by approximately 30% (according to Real Clear Politics). Trump is the 1st Republican Presidential candidate in modern history to win both Iowa and New Hampshire. Sooner rather than later, Haley's ability to fundraise will vanish.
