RIP Sgt. Ryan Knauss

Yesterday, Sgt. Ryan Knauss, who was killed in Afghanistan, got to see Virginia one last time before being interred in Arlington National Cemetary. Yesterday his body was driven through Virginia, heading north on 81 down the Valley, and then coming onto 66.

So many of you came out to honor Sgt. Knauss on 81 and 66, either standing on overpasses or on the side of the road to honor Sgt. Knauss. It was a fitting tribute, one that Sgt. Knauss deserved.
