#### Cracking Down on High Speed Chases With Illegal Immigrants Fleeing Arrest

In 2022, Border Patrol Agent <u>Raul Gonzalez Jr.</u> tragically passed away in a car crash while chasing illegal migrants who were fleeing arrest. Unfortunately, high-speed pursuits involving law enforcement officials and illegal migrants have become <u>common</u> and in many cases they are <u>fatal</u> <u>accidents</u>. That is unacceptable. We need to make sure that anyone who enters our country illegally and endangers the lives of any American citizen faces serious consequences.

In honor of Agent Raul Gonzalez, Jr., and his sacrifice while fighting to protect our southern border, House Republicans passed <u>H.R. 5585, the Agent Raul Gonzalez Officer Safety Act</u>, which creates new criminal offenses for operating a vehicle within 100 miles of the southern border while fleeing from Border Patrol agents, or any law enforcement officer assisting the U.S. Border Patrol, including serious jail time and prohibition from ever receiving legal status in the United States. We will always have the backs of our law enforcement officers and protect those who protect our community.



Banning Hamas Terrorists From Entering the United States

The State of Israel has been and continues to be our greatest democratic ally in the Middle East.

On October 7th, the Iranian-backed terrorist group Hamas declared war on Israel and chanted "Death to Israel and "Death to America," further cementing themselves as enemies of the United States and our ally Israel. Due to Biden's border crisis, these same terrorists are flooding across our southern border. In FY23, Customs and Border Patrol apprehended <u>169 individuals on the terror watch list</u> at our southern border.

These terrorists, who loathe America and all it represents, cannot be allowed to enter our borders and cause chaos in our communities. That is why House Republicans passed <u>H.R. 6679, the No</u> <u>Immigration Benefits</u> for Hamas Terrorists Act, which ensures that these bad actors do not find refuge in our country.



Restoring Pro-Growth Tax Policies and Countering Bidenflation

Small businesses and the folks who run them are the backbone of our economy and they've shown tremendous strength during these unprecedented times. That's why this week the House of Representatives passed the <u>Tax Relief</u> for <u>American Families and Workers Act</u> to help small businesses grow, create jobs, raises wages, and saves taxpayers \$75 billion by ending a COVID-era program that has been plagued by runaway spending and rampant fraud. In addition, the bill measures the child family tax credit to reflect the recent Bidenflation and indexes to adjust for future inflation.

The legislation locks in \$600 billion of pro-growth, pro-worker tax policy by restoring incentives from the 2017 <u>Tax Cuts and Jobs Act (TCJA)</u>.
