

President Biden Sends \$10 Billion More To Iran



#### Fighting to Secure the Border

According to a new <u>report</u> from U.S. Customs and Border Protection (CBP), there were 240,988 illegal crossings at the southern border last month, making it the highest number ever recorded in October. This brings the total number of illegal border crossings nationwide to 7.8 million, in addition to over 1.7 million known "gotaways" who evaded U.S. Border Patrol.

The Biden Administration's failed policy decisions are only aiding and abetting this invasion at our open border. That is why earlier this year, House Republicans passed the <u>Secure the Border Act (H.R. 2)</u>, which will end President Biden's open border and amnesty policies driving this crisis, reform our asylum laws, provide Border Patrol agents more resources, and force the Administration to restart construction of the border wall. It's far past time the Senate passes this strong border security package.
