Biden Border Crisis Resignations Growing, and More Needed

Responding to recent pressure from me and my colleagues, the Commissioner of U.S. Customs and Border Protection (CBP) Chris Magnus announced that he has tendered his resignation. This comes after a record-breaking year for the number of migrants attempting to enter the United States through the southern border. Commissioner Magnus failed to uphold the CBP's core mission: to protect our borders, support our border patrol officers, and keep America safe.

While this resignation is a good start, the lack of enforcement begins with the failure of President Biden and Secretary Mayorkas to secure our border from record numbers of illegals and drugs flowing into our country. It is past time they take responsibility for their incompetent handling of the border crisis, and when the 118th Congress convenes in January, one of its first duties will be holding this administration accountable for its willful dereliction of duty.

Toxic Exposure Screenings Available for Veterans

While all Veterans are eligible for screening, if you served in Iraq or Afghanistan and are at an increased risk of toxic exposure, I urge you to take advantage of new toxic exposure screenings offered through the VA. For Veterans enrolled in VA health care, the VA states that Veterans can now receive the screening at their next VA health care appointment. If you qualify and want to be screened sooner, however, contact your <u>local VA facility</u> and ask to be screened by the Toxic Exposure Screening Navigator. 
Small Business Saturday
