During his tenure, our country has experienced an unprecedented crisis that has empowered the cartels, increased human trafficking, spiked the flow of fentanyl, and put each and every American citizen's life at risk. aliens who represented potential threats to national security.

CBP seized an all-time record of over <u>27,000 pounds</u> of fentanyl at the Southwest border. These seizures are far more than enough to kill every American in the country.


