Trump Wins A Landslide Victory in South Carolina

Over the weekend, Donald Trump won a landslide victory in SC, beating former SC Governor Nikki Haley in 44 of SC's 46 counties/cities. The rules of delegate selection are somewhat unclear, some say that the delegate apportionment of SC is "winner take all", while others say that there is a hybrid system which apportions approximately 27 delegates in a winner take all, and the rest are apportioned by how many locales you win. So either Trump won 44 of 50 delegates, or all 50 delegates. Either or, former Ambassador Haley was humiliated in her own back yard.

Tonight the Great State of Michigan will announce their primary results (Michigan GOP voters go to the polls today). 55 delegates will be awarded on a hybrid basis. Trump is favored to win by more than 20%. Given the fact that Michigan allows for cross over voting, a 20% win for Trump will be great news. If Democrats were not allowed to vote, the margin would most likely be 80-20% for Trump.

So far Haley has only promised to stay in the race through March 5 – Super Tuesday (remember that Virginia holds the Presidential Primary that day – you can still early vote up through this coming Saturday), there is no real good reason for former Ambassador/Governor Haley to stay in the race now. It's over and the sooner that Haley realizes this the better off everyone will be. She tried hard, and she didn't get what she wanted. I wish her well. I also hope that she will learn something from this loss. Nikki Haley does have a future in the GOP, just not as President this time around. (Quite frankly I'd prefer she not run for President in 2028 either until she takes time and learns about regular people in a way she didn't understand this time around).
